

WELFARE ACTIVITIES OFFERED BY **PAKISTAN POST FOUNDATION**



MARRIAGE GRANT

The postal employees (Serving/ retired) from BS-1 to BS-9 are eligible for Marriage Grant in respect of one daughter if applied within one year of marriage.



EDUCATION GRANT (SCHOLARSHIP)

- Students of serving/retired postal employees acquiring education from recognized institutions are eligible for education Grant subject to securing 80% marks up to Intermediate level and 70% marks above Intermediate.
- Distinction Award to Students on securing 1st, 2nd & 3rd position Education Board.
- Payment of Semester fee to children of postal employees (BPS 1-16) on securing above 65% marks in Courses from Allama Iqbal Open University.

- Stipend Award of Rs. 5,000/- to children (upto 18 years age) of postal employees on completion of Hifz-e-Quran during last one year.



MEDICAL LOAN

Grant of medical loan (Refundable) is admissible to serving Postal Officers/ employees of Pakistan Post suffering from Chronic diseases viz, Cardiac Surgery, TB, Hepatitis and Cancer and credit of entire loan on grant of Reimbursement bill by PPOD. In case of non submission of Reimbursement bill, refund of loan in 20 installments subject to provision of advance post dated cheques.



FINANCIAL AID TO WIDOWS

- Lump sum grant and monthly aid would be paid to widow of the deceased postal employees (s) on death or serious injury in terrorist act, robberies and cash looting attacks in the line of active duty at the prescribed rates.

- Funeral Grant of Rs. 5,000/- to widow of postal employees on death of her/his spouse during service



FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR MEDICAL TREATMENT

Financial assistance of maximum Rs. 10,000/- for Medical treatment to postal employees provided they avail it only from the recognized hospitals.



RECOVERY GRANT

A lump sum grant is admissible to the dependents of injured postal employees (BS-1 to BS-16) subject to the conditions that postal official injured in the line of active duty and the claim of compensation is preferred during the same financial year.
