
S.R.O. No. 1198(1)/2020.- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 25 of the Civil Servants Act, 1973 (LXXI of 1973), read with Notification No.S.R.O.120(1)/98, dated the 27th February, 1998, the Prime Minister is pleased to direct that the following amendments shall be made in the Civil Servants (Service in International Organizations) Rules, 2016, namely:-

In the aforesaid Rules, in the Schedule,-

- (a) the existing entry shall be numbered as "1."; and,
- (b) after the existing entry, numbered as aforesaid, the following new entry shall be added, namely:-

"2. Any post, other than an open post, in an International Organization that has been offered to Pakistan under any bilateral or multilateral arrangement and has been notified by Establishment Division with the approval of the Prime Minister".
